## UTILITIES OFFICER (CID: M03ACE2)

**PREREQUISITES:** Graduate of the Warrant Officer Basic Course (M02RMN4) and designated for MOS 1120.

**OUTCOME:** To produce a critical thinking Utilities Warrant Officer to the Fleet Marine Force that is able to leverage data systems and processes to manage maintenance and other programs, support the planning process across the competition continuum, supervise Motor-T maintenance and Motor-T support operations, advise commanders on the use and exploitation of critical infrastructure, mitigate signature, risk, and cost in the supply and use of energy, and utilize foundational knowledge of the science behind energy and water technologies to find solutions that fill utilities capability gaps in the Fleet Marine Force.

**SCOPE:** This course is designed to impart the knowledge, skills, and abilities required of Warrant Officers to advise commanders on shaping operational energy, infrastructure assessment, and use of current and emerging technologies for energy and water production. Additionally, this course provides instruction on managing a Utilities, Engineer Equipment, Motor Transport and/or Maintenance Platoon or Section in the Fleet Marine Force.

Students report to Commanding Officer, Marine Corps Engineer School, Courthouse Bay, Camp Lejeune, North Carolina.
